**AN ACT TO AMEND § 54102(c) OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 54, DIVISION 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO TRANSITIONING SUPPORT FOR NON-HIGHWAY AND NON-TRANSPORTATION OBLIGATIONS FROM THE GUAM HIGHWAY FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.**

**1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 54102(c) of Article 1, Chapter 54, Division 5, Title 5,  
3 Guam Code Annotated, is amended, to read:

4 “(c) Monies deposited in the Territorial Highway Fund shall be  
5 expended only after appropriation thereof is made by the Legislature and  
6 upon vouchers properly certified by the Director of Public Works for the  
7 purposes of acquisition of right-of-ways, planning, designing,  
8 constructing, reconstructing, improving, repairing, and maintaining of  
9 public highways, including roads and city and village streets. Beginning  
10 with the General Appropriations Act of 2019 and for the two subsequent  
11 Budget Acts, I Liheslaturan Guåhan shall reassign no less than one-  
12 third (1/3) in non-highway/non-transportation related support, including  
13 appropriations to the Mayors Council of Guam, Guam Police  
14 Department, and the Department of Revenue and Taxation (Better  
15 Public Service Fund), from the Guam Highway Fund to the General



1 Fund. Funding previously assigned to support non-highway/non-  
2 transportation obligations shall then be made available by I Liheslatura  
3 to the Department of Public Works for road repair and construction  
4 projects pursuant to the Guam Village Streets Master Plan, commencing  
5 with the three (3) priority projects as updated by each village mayor and  
6 approved by the Director of Public Works. Notwithstanding any other  
7 provision of law, no monies in the Fund shall be expended for purposes  
8 other than provided for in this Section. The Fund is exempt from any  
9 transfer authority.

10       The Director of Public Works shall quarterly render an accounting  
11 of transactions of the Fund to the Governor and the Legislature.  
12 Accounting procedures for the Fund shall be prescribed by the Director  
13 of Administration.”
